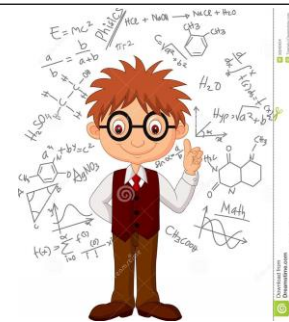
Dear Parents and Caregivers

Welcome to Term Four in the Treehouse. As I write this I wonder where the rest of the year has gone!

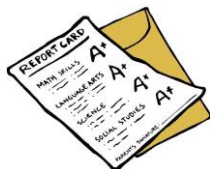
